



EMOTIONAL SUPPORT ANIMAL APPLICATION

Saskatchewan Housing Corporation is committed to providing an accessible environment for tenants with disabilities. Under *The Saskatchewan Human Rights Code, 2018 (the Code)*, a tenant with a disability may be entitled to have an emotional support animal as a reasonable accommodation.

To apply for an emotional support animal accommodation, complete this form and submit it to your housing authority. You must include the following completed documents to support your application:

- Medical Verification for an Emotional Support Animal Accommodation Form, completed by a mental health professional
- Emotional Support Animal Emergency Caregiver Contact Form
- Documentation of up-to-date vaccinations and spay/neuter, if applicable
- Documentation the animal is registered/licensed by the local municipality, if applicable

DECLARATION

I declare that all the information in this application is true and complete.

I understand that this application does not obligate the housing authority to approve my request for an accommodation and the accommodation could be denied by the housing authority if the animal:

- is not necessary for support in the home;
- does not demonstrate the applicable, required behavioural standards;
- poses a threat to the health and safety of others; or
- interferes with others' right to quiet enjoyment.

I understand:

- if my accommodation is approved I must sign a Lease Addendum agreeing to the regulations for keeping an emotional support animal.
- if any information in my application is found to be false, my application might not be considered or my accommodation for an emotional support animal might be revoked.
- the housing authority must balance the rights of its tenants and might request feedback from or provide notice to other tenants about the presence of an animal in the building.
- the information I provide during the application process and my tenancy will remain confidential and will be collected, used, kept, and disposed of as required by law.
